### 4.02.04 – Student Dress

Policy Approved: 2010.05.26

#### POLICY

The Board of Trustees believes that extremes in clothing, hairstyle, or personal ornaments may be detrimental influences in schools and classrooms. Consequently, a teacher or principal may request a student to correct a condition in dress or personal appearance that appears to be a deliberate attempt to disrupt the teaching and learning process, offend convention or attract undue attention. If, after a reasonable interval, the student fails to correct the condition, he or she may be excluded from class until he has complied with the request.

Teachers should consult with their principals when there is doubt about the propriety of a student's dress.
