



Accommodation Committee Recommendations: SCENARIO E

1. Implementation of the following recommendations will be effective with the start of the 2017/18 school year.
2. Inglewood School Boundaries:
 - a. Inglewood school will be designated an English K to 5 program serving Southeast Red Deer.
 - b. English students residing in the Inglewood and Ironstone communities will move from Mountview to Inglewood. French Immersion students residing in Inglewood and Ironstone will continue to attend Mountview.
 - c. English students residing in the Vanier Woods/Vanier East communities will move from Barrie Wilson to Inglewood.
3. Grandview Elementary Repurposing:
 - a. Grandview school will be repurposed as a Spanish bilingual single-track program for students from K to 5 with potential to expand to K to 8 if there is sufficient interest for a viable program.
 - b. Students residing in the Grandview, Michener Hill, Downtown, Parkvale, Woodlea, and Waskasoo communities will move from Grandview to Mountview.
 - c. Students residing in Rosedale and Rosedale Meadow communities will move from Grandview to Barrie Wilson.
 - d. Students residing outside of the existing catchment area for Grandview school will attend their neighborhood school, or school of choice where room and resources are available.
4. French Immersion continues to be dual track
 - a. At this time, elementary French Immersion programming at Barrie Wilson, Mountview and Oriole Park will be provided in a dual track environment complemented by English programming.
5. Mountview Redistribution
 - a. English students residing in the Mountview, Bower and Westerner Park communities will continue attending Mountview.
 - b. English students residing in the Inglewood and Ironstone communities will move from Mountview to Inglewood.
 - c. Students residing in the Grandview, Michener Hill, Downtown, Parkvale, Woodlea, and Waskasoo communities will move from Grandview to Mountview.
 - d. Students in French Immersion residing south of 32nd Street and East of 30th Avenue (Lancaster and Vanier communities) will move from Barrie Wilson to Mountview.

6. Laredo redirected to Mattie McCullough
 - a. Students residing in the Laredo community will move from Barrie Wilson to Mattie McCullough.
 - b. The attendance boundaries recommendations take into account shifting demographics and student projections for Laredo and the other Lancaster communities.

7. Barrie Wilson redistribution
 - a. Barrie Wilson will be resized to accommodate anticipated residential growth in North East Red Deer.
 - b. Students residing in the Vanier Woods/Vanier East communities will move from Barrie Wilson to Inglewood.
 - c. Students residing in Rosedale and Rosedale Meadow communities will move from Grandview to Barrie Wilson.
 - d. Students residing in the Laredo community will move from Barrie Wilson to Mattie McCullough.
 - e. Students in French Immersion residing south of 32nd Street and East of 30th Avenue (Lancaster and Vanier communities) will move from Barrie Wilson to Mountview.
 - f. Restrictions will be in place limiting access to students attending the Barrie Wilson from outside the designated attendance boundaries.
 - g. Additional relocatable classroom space will increase capacity of the school. Request for four classrooms at 25 spaces at this location has been made to Alberta Education – subject to approval and timing.

8. Accommodating future growth at Gateway Christian School
 - a. Anticipated growth of student population.
 - b. Students attending Gateway Christian school in grades 9 to 12 will make increased use of shared facilities at Lindsay Thurber, enhancing the “Gurber” experience.
 - c. Gateway will work to maximize existing learning space in the current facility.
 - d. Additional relocatable classroom space will increase capacity of the school. Request for four classrooms at 25 spaces at this location has been made to Alberta Education – subject to approval and timing.

9. Pines School and Spanish Bilingual
 - a. Students currently attending Escuela Pines K to 5 will move to Grandview. September 2017 will be the first year for grade 5 programming.
 - b. Anticipated growth of student population due to grade expansion and increased interest.
 - c. If there is sufficient interest to ensure a viable program, the intent would be for the Spanish Bilingual Program to expand to a K to 8 program.
 - d. The attendance boundaries recommendations take into account potential student attrition due to the relocation of the school. It also anticipates general attrition rates when students in bilingual programs transition from elementary to middle school.
 - e. Pines School will be available for future use to accommodate a growing North East Red Deer should facilities be needed.

10. Fairview school maintains elementary English As a Second Language
 - a. Fairview will maintain its existing boundaries including English as a second language congregated programming for elementary students.

11. Schools of Choice

- a. Families will continue to be able to access schools of choice where room and resources permit as per Policy 4.01.03 - Parent Choice of Schools. However, to ensure accommodations for future growth, schools will need to anticipate and be able to accommodate students residing within their designated attendance area.

12. Middle and High Feeder Schools

- a. Students attending Inglewood School will be directed to the following middle schools
 - i. Inglewood/Ironstone to Eastview Middle School – which is the current attendance area.
 - ii. Vanier Woods/Vanier East to Westpark Middle School – which is the current attendance area.
- b. Middle School feeders for all other elementary schools will continue as they currently are.
- c. High School feeder schools will continue as per the current geographic boundaries.

13. As has been the district's practice with previous attendance boundary reconfigurations, a grandfathering provision will be made for students entering grade 5 in September 2017 to remain at their current school. However, student transportation services will not be provided as this will not be the student's designated school.

14. Current student transportation policy and procedures will determine walk limits, student eligibility, transportation fees, etc.
